A camp information evening will take place in the gym on **Tuesday 13 February at 6.15 pm** [prior to 'Meet the Teacher' which commences at 7.00 pm].

All the camps are four-day camps. It is imperative that we confirm student participation as soon as possible. Please sign and return the attached permission slip by Friday 8 March.

We will require parent helpers, to ensure the experience is both safe and enjoyable for all concerned. If **you** are able to volunteer for a great week, we ask that you complete the form attached and return it to your child's teacher as soon as possible. Please indicate your preference regarding the role you would like to undertake. Once we have confirmed our camp parent helpers, there will be a further meeting for these parents accompanying us to camp on **Wednesday 13 March**, **7.00 - 8.00 pm**. It is really important that parent helpers attend this meeting.

Camp payment:

The Year 7 camp is an extracurricular activity and the cost for student participation in the camp is **\$445.00**. Payment for camp is made via Kindo, our school's online payment system. Please go to our website **www.somervilleintermediate.school.nz** and click **Parent's Online Payments** and Kindo in the menu bar on the home page. If you have already registered for Kindo, click 'Registered User' or click 'New User' to register.

The final day to confirm your child's participation in the camp, by payment in full, is **Friday 8 March 2024**. Payment options that include paying the camp off over time can be discussed and organised with Chris Hall or Steph Ready prior to this date.
